Workshop Aim:

This workshop offers you an opportunity to:

- Increase your understanding of small group processes, both conscious and unconscious, through membership of a small group
- Experience in some sessions the role of a consultant of a small study group and have an opportunity to review that experience

Primary Task

The primary task of the workshop is to understand what is happening in the group in terms of conscious and unconscious processes in the here and now.

Methodology

The workshop is rooted in the Tavistock tradition of work on group relations and socio-analysis. Participating members will as members, and as "consultants" when authorized to take on that role, have an opportunity to understand through here and now experience and interventions the processes in small groups. It is hoped that this experience will help them work better in small group situations in a variety of roles.
